GOLF GENIUS (GG)

We are still learning the operation of our new booking and scoring software and appreciate your feedback.

An issue arose at Carbrook that emphasised the need for guests to use the GGID code issued the day before the game, not just click on the one stored in the phone. The GGID code is unique to each game and will provide the correct game with playing partners and current playing handicap.

We are working with GG to have the stableford score shown on the screen and highlight the dots in a stronger colour to signify where you have shots on a hole.
